**ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENT TO RULE 8 OF THE RULES OF THE
WYOMING STATE BOARD OF CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION**

The Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education has recommended that the Wyoming Supreme Court amend Rule 8 of the Rules of the Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education. The Court, having carefully reviewed the proposed amendment, finds that the proposed amendment should be adopted. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that the amendment to Rule 8 of the Rules of the Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education, attached hereto, be and hereby is adopted by the Court to be effective January 1, 2009; and it is further

ORDERED that the amendment to Rule 8 of the Rules of the Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education, attached hereto, shall be published in the advance sheets of the Pacific Reporter, the Wyoming Reporter, and in the Wyoming Court Rules; and that the amendment to Rule 8 of the Rules of the Wyoming State Board of Continuing Legal Education shall thereupon be spread at length upon the journal of the Court.

Rule 8. Exemptions.
