Wyoming Court Security Standard 2014-1

As directed by the Wyoming Court Security Act, W.S. § 5-11-101(e) the following standard is established:

Incident Reporting:

In order to better protect life, property, and the judicial process in Wyoming, the Wyoming Court Security Commission has undertaken an incident reporting process. It is the intention of the Commission to use this data to strengthen our court security around the state and eliminate any deficiencies that are detected following security incidents. All courts are tasked with submitting the Commission's standard incident reporting form within five business days of an incident's occurrence. Examples of security incidents include but are not limited to:

- Physical Assault
- Bomb Threat
- Written/Verbal Threat
- Disorderly Conduct
- Fire/Weather/Medical
Emergency
- Prisoner Escape Attempt
- Attempt to Bring in
Firearm/Weapon
- Hostage Situation
- Theft
- Vandalism/Property
Damage
- Attempt to Bring in
Drugs/Contraband
- Suspicious Circumstances
