ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ALLOWING DISTRICT COURTS TO CHARGE
VOLUNTARY LIBRARY FEES

THIS MATTER came before the Court by recommendation of the Board of Judicial Policy and Administration to adopt a policy regarding the assessment of library fees by the district courts. It is therefore,

ORDERED that the district courts within the State of Wyoming are allowed to charge a library fee, not to exceed \$25.00. Funds collected under this order are to be received by the district court and specifically used for the purchase of library materials. District courts are permitted to assess the library fee, however, payment is voluntary. District courts are not allowed to make the library fee mandatory or to reject a filing for failure to pay the fee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the district courts will post this order in a public and conspicuous location.
