## Rules For Fees and Costs for Circuit Courts

### **Rule 1. Costs and fees in criminal actions.**

(a) Circuit courts shall collect for every criminal/traffic charge (count) for which a conviction results unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, costs in the sum of \$20.00 which shall be assessed as part of the sentence. In addition, for every criminal/traffic charge (count) for which a conviction results unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, a fee of \$10.00 shall be imposed and shall be deposited into the judicial systems automation account established by W.S. § 5-2-120.
