**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ALLOWING DISTRICT COURTS
TO CHARGE ADDITIONAL VOLUNTARY FILING FEES**

THIS MATTER came before the Court by recommendation of the Board of Judicial Policy and Administration to replace General Order 00-03, and to amend the policy regarding the assessment of library fees by the district courts. It is therefore,


ORDERED that the district courts within the State of Wyoming are allowed to charge an additional filing fee, not to exceed \$25.00. Funds collected under this order are to be received by the district court and specifically used for the purchase of library materials, courtroom improvements and equipment, and for such other purposes as may from time to time be approved by the District Court in consultation with the appropriate County Bar Association; and it is further

ORDERED that the District Courts are permitted to assess the fee, however, payment is voluntary. District Courts are not allowed to make the fee mandatory or to reject a filing for failure to pay the fee; and it is further

ORDERED that General Order 00-03 be, and hereby is, rescinded.
