




circumstances[.]” Wyo. R. Civ. P. 5(e). Normally, the Clerk of District Court charges a fee for electronic filing. *Id.* Under Rule 4 of the Rules For Fees and Costs for District Court, facsimile filing costs \$1.00 per page. Fax or email filing should only be used “under emergency circumstances[.]” Wyo. R. Civ. P. 5(e). When no emergency exists, pleadings and papers should still be filed via regular mail if the party or attorney is not filing the paper or pleading in person. Finally, fax filings are limited to ten pages.


In light of the current pandemic, the Clerk and Judges of the District Court recognize that anything to minimize person-to-person contact, including minimizing the cost of filing a paper or pleading under emergency circumstances via electronic means, is in the public health’s best interest. Consequently, the Clerk of District Court for Campbell County has agreed to waive any fees associated with filing documents via electronic means, whether it be via fax or e-mail (where available).


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that until further order of this Court, the filing fee assessed for fax filing is hereby **SUSPENDED**;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all other requirements for electronic filing including, but not limited to, the requirements of emergency circumstances and prompt payment, shall remain in full force and effect.
