## ORDER REGARDING ENTRY TO COURTROOM OR CLERKS' OFFICES

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the Wyoming Supreme Court's *Order Adopting Temporary Plan to Address Health Risks Posed by the COVID-19 Pandemic*. The Court Orders as follows:

- 1. The following persons shall not enter the Courtroom or the Clerks' Offices:
  - a. Those who have travelled to China, Iran, South Korea, any European Country, or any other high-risk country identified by the CDC in the previous 14 days;
  - b. Those persons who have resided with or been in close contact with someone who has been in any of those countries within the previous 14 days;
  - c. Those persons who have traveled domestically within the United States where COVID-19 (Coronavirus) has community transmission;
  - d. Those who have been asked or instructed to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
  - e. Those who have been diagnosed with or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 (Coronavirus); or
  - f. A fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
- 2. No person shall congregate outside courtroom doors.
- 3. This Order shall continue until further order of the Court.
