ORDER RE PAYMENT OF FEES

- 1. On March 18, 2020 the Wyoming Supreme Court issued an *Order Adopting Temporary Plan to Address Health Risks Posed by the COVID-19 Pandemic*. The Order is available at: http://www.courts.state.wy.us/wp-content/uploads/2020/03/COVID-19-Order.pdf
- 2. The Wyoming Supreme Court's Order is effective March 18, 2020 through April 10, 2020.
- 3. Further, on March 20, 2020, the Teton County Board of County Commissioners closed all public buildings, including the Courthouse, from March 23 through April 3, 2020. Staff in the agencies and courts located in the Courthouse may conduct in-person business with the public by appointment only, and one case at a time. In accordance with that decision, the Teton County Sheriff's Office has locked the doors to the courthouse. - 4. Therefore, through May 1, 2020, the Circuit Court will not accept cash payments for fines, surcharges, costs, fees and restitution presented at the counter. You may still pay fines, surcharges, costs, fees and restitution by certified or bank check by mail or other courier service. Personal checks are not accepted.
- 5. <u>CITEPAYUSA.COM</u>. However, you may pay fines, surcharges, costs, fees and restitution online at <u>citepayusa.com</u>. Paying on <u>citepayusa.com</u> adds charges to the fines, surcharges, costs, fees and restitution ordered by the court. Upon written request emailed, faxed or mailed to the court, the court will consider reducing the fines, surcharges, costs and fees (but not restitution) owed by the fees charged by <u>citepayusa.com</u>.
- 6. <u>EXTENSIONS</u>. Upon written request emailed, faxed or mailed to the court, the court will consider extending the time within which fines, surcharges, costs, fees and restitution are due.
