Rules for Continuing Judicial Education

Rule 3. Hours of accredited continuing judicial education defined.

(h) One (1) hour of continuing judicial education credit will be given for every two hours of service provided by sitting judges who serve on committees established by Court order, not to exceed 50% of the annual continuing judicial education credit requirement per calendar year. ~~The judges who serve on the following committees shall qualify for continuing judicial education credit:~~
