AMENDMENT NO. 1 – MAY 26, 2021


The current Covid-19 Jury Trial Operating Plan, approved March 15, 2021, was drafted at a time when the risk level in Teton County, Wyoming was Orange, or moderate, under Teton County’s Covid-19 Metrics.

On May 12, 2021, the risk level moved from Yellow, or moderate, to Green, or “new normal.”

Therefore for jury trials, or those portions of jury trials, that take place when the Risk Level is Green, the current Covid-19 Jury Trial Operating Plan, approved March 15, 2021, is amended as follows:


- Once participants, including the jury, are seated in the courtroom or jury deliberation room (the District Courtroom), the wearing of masks is optional.
- Social Distancing of at least 6 feet is still required among participants, including jurors, when seated, but relaxed when the participants move from one location to another (e.g., the jury moving to the District Courtroom for a break or for deliberations).
